### 1907 LETTER FROM IRELAND

#### & Romantic Enclosures for Fiancee

Rev. J. Harvey Dunham (1872-1943)(10)(John 1, Benijah 2, Edmond 3, Jonathan 4, Jonathan 5, Jonathan 6, Nahum 7, Samuel 8, Henry 9) married Lena Louise Crammond in 1908. Prior to that time Rev. Dunham made a trip to Ireland, & he sent this letter back to his sweetheart. The copy comes to DD thanks to their granddaughter, Donna Hawks, Spring, TX. We'll do our best to transcribe the difficult handwriting!

"Glengarriffe, Ireland, Belle Vue Hotel, Sunday, June 9, 1907. My dear Lena: Europe & Irish soil! Landed very early Sat. a.m. after a night of fog on the deep. Was transferred about 4 o'clock to a tender & taken to Queenstown Harbor. The duke & dutchess of Manchester were aboard. The duke impressed me as being an Ass. She was all right.

"After the customs house ordeal, in which I had to show my 'bottle,' bot ticket for Cork. Was driven to hotel, & after breakfast took 'jaunting car' to Blarney Castle. The ride was most enjoyable & the scenery grand. Ireland for green every time. They have the greenest grass her I ever saw. The fields & fences are simply flower gardens, most lovely. The people are distressingly poor.

"From Cork went to Bantry, the finest bay on the coast. It was market day, & every laddy was in town with his wife & pig in a 2-wheeled cart drawn by a donkey.

"After dinner in Bantry with a little girl who attended my ch in Cleister took the boat for Glengarriffe. It was a lovely ride & so very pretty that I could not enjoy it because you were not seeing it.

"Am spending a quiet Sunday. Went to the Eng. ch. this a.m. Heard a good sermon but nearly froze to death. Tomorrow I am going to take the coach to Kenmere, thence to Killarney by rail & about Tuesday will go to Dublin & look for a letter from you. I wonder how you are & it will be grand to see you again. Went to the hotel piano this a.m. & played a few strains of "Home, Sweet Home'-- & I came nearly shedding tears. Remember me to all the home peo., Lena. Don't work too hard. Take a good rest this summer.

"I send a rose leaf & a leaf of Irish green.

"With love & devotion, Yours, HARVEY."

James Harvey Dunham (1872-1943) Raymond Henry Dunham (1910-1986) Doris Bailey, Plainwell, MI, gets the credit for noticing & sending in this clipping from The Kalamazoo Gazette last fall.. Doris wondered if the young man profiled here might be some relation to DD's Phyllis Kitson. He is! She is proud to say that Jeff is her grandson, a 14th generation Dunham descendant, & a wonderful, multi-talented young man. An honor student at Flint Central, Jeff is headed for Michigan State University as a music major this fall. (We wouldn't do all this bragging if someone ELSE hadn't sent in the clipping, but it is great to have this opportunity to do it. After all, what are grandmothers for? They bake cookies, & they BRAG!)

A couple of times in the past DD has published photographs of Miss Jane Dunham (1906-1994)(110)(John I. John 2, John 3, Elisha 4, Elisha 5, Elijah 6, Solomon 7, Mark 8, Wirth 9). It was Jane's grandfather who built the Dunham Castle in Wayne, IL, & Jane herself was the founder of the Dunham-Hunt Museum in St. Charles. The photo at right, which we have through the kindness of Harold Leeman, Lansing, MI, shows that Jane did not always appear to be the dignified grande dame of her later years. Probably taken in the 1920's, this small snapshot shows Jane striking a jaunty pose & wearing what would then have been called "beach pajamas," the only
