# Civil War Research Yields Dunham Identifications

We all know that locating our ancestors in the State or Federal Census records can help identify our ancestors and learn the names of their children. While compiling the list of the Dunhams who gave service during the Civil War, I was able to trace a Dunham line which has not yet been covered in this newsletter. This line begins with a Thomas Dunham who appears in New Jersey, and moved to Seneca and Tompkins Counties, New York. I had known about this line for a long time, but had not completed my research on all the branches.

## The Line of Thomas Dunham

Work on this line was done almost a century ago by Jerry Crary of Warren PA and privately printed by him in 1916. Entitled "*Ancestors and Descendants of Richard Dunham and his wife Laura Allen*" his work presents information that seems to have been gathered from personal research. When DSFC researcher Bill Burke and I were working on the New York Census records we identified some of the descendants of Thomas Dunham. The discovery of an Ezariah Dunham in the *Record of Service of Michigan Volunteers in the Civil War, 1861-1865* prompted me to try to learn more about this man with an unusual given name. The entry in the listing of Michigan Volunteers reads "**Ezariah Dunham**, Enlisted 4<sup>th</sup> Cavalry February 11, 1864 at Coe, for 3 yrs. age 44. Mustered Aug. 29, 1862. Mustered out Nashville, TN July 1, 1865." Coe is in Isabella County, Michigan, and the age at enlistment would make his birth year about 1820.

A search of the Michigan 1860 and 1870 census records for Ezariah Dunham shows him as follows:

Another entry in the *Record of Service of Michigan Volunteers in the Civil War, 1861-1865* shows a **Charles Dunham**, also with service from Coe, Michigan. “**Charles A. Dunham**, Enlisted in Company G. 4<sup>th</sup> Cavalry November 20, 1863 at Coe, age 18. Mustered Dec. 9, 1863. Joined Regiment at Nashville, TN Feb. 28, 1864. Transferred to Company I April 2, 1864. Discharged at Edgefield, TN Aug. 15, 1865.” From the age at enlistment Charles Dunham would have been born about 1845. In looking at the 1860 Michigan census it appears that the Charles Dunham, son of Ezariah Dunham born about 1846, and the Charles Dunham who enlisted at Coe, Michigan are the same person.

## The Search for Ezariah Dunham

Ezariah/Ezeriah/Azeriah Dunham was born in New York State according to the 1860 census. The county boundaries are important and it should be noted that Tompkins County was formed in 1817 from the neighboring counties of Cayuga and Seneca. In 1854 the town of Hector, Tompkins County became a part of Schuyler County, New York.

According to Dunham researcher Olive Richardson, Ezeriah was born in NJ 13 June 1777. We find **Ezeriah Dunham** in Ovid, Seneca County NY in 1810 census, p. 149; 10010-31010. The males in this family would be 1 male 26-44 (b. 1766-1784), and 1 male under 10 (b. 1800-1810). The older man is Ezeriah and the younger male is probably a son Eli Dunham born about 1801.

The 1820 census of Hector, Tompkins County, New York shows an Azariah Dunham living in Hector, Tompkins County, New York with a family of 1 male under 10 (b.1810-1820); 1 male 16-25 (b. 1794-1804); 1 male 26-44 (b. 1776-1794); 3 females under 10; 3 females 10-15. Note that there is no female the proper age to be the wife of Azeriah Dunham, thus we might consider that his wife had died. The older man is Ezeriah, b. 1777; the next oldest male is Eli, b. about 1801; and the youngest male is James M., b. 1815.

In 1821 Azariah Dunham (the father) furnished land for a school site. [Tompkins Co. Deeds D:56, part of Lot 69 in Hector] Azariah Dunham (the father) died 10 March 1869 and is buried beside his wife Mary (21 June 1782-Oct. 1861) in the Reynoldsville Cemetery, Montour Falls, Schuyler County, New York.

The 1830 census of Hector, Tompkins County, New York shows Azariah Dunham with a family of 1 male 5-10 (b. 1820-1825); 1 male 15-20 (b. 1810-1815); 1 male 60-70 (b. 1760-1770). The female age categories are 1 female age 10-15 (b. 1815-1820); 1 female 15-20 (b. 1810-1815); 1 female 40-50 (b. 1780-1790). From the cemetery headstone of Mary Dunham, she was born in 1782, and would have been the second wife of Azeriah Dunham. The youngest male in this family b. 1820-1825 would be the Ezeriah Dunham who is the one who served in the Civil War from Michigan. The next oldest would be James M. Dunham b. 1815, and the oldest male would be Azariah Dunham b. 1777 (but perhaps marked in the wrong column.)

The 1840 Census of Hector, Tompkins County, New York shows Azariah Dunham with a

family of 1 m. 10-15 (b. 1825-1830); 1 m. 15-20 (b. 1820-1825); 1 m. 60-70 (b. 1770-1780). The oldest male is Azariah Dunham b. 1777, the next oldest male is Azeriah Dunham b. 1820 who served in the Civil War, and the youngest male is Johnson A. Dunham born about 1824. DSFC researcher Bill Burke has found that Johnson A. Dunham married Harriet M. Moreland. Both died in Kent County, Michigan.

The 1850 Census of Veteran, Chemung County, New York shows Azariah Dunham, age 72, and Mary Dunham age 68. They appear to be living with other family members, but that census is very faint and it is difficult to identify those family members.

Azariah Dunham, (the father) appears on the 1860 census in Hector, Schuyler County, New York living with his daughter Eliza Shannon who was born in 1818. Azariah Dunham was age 83, so born in 1777, and his wife Mary was age 78, so born in 1782. She was probably his second wife as the 1820 census does not show a female old enough to be a wife of Azariah.

### **Connecting the Family of Azariah/Ezeriah Dunham**

From the research done by Jerry Crary and published by him in 1916, we learn that “**Thomas<sup>1</sup> Dunham** (b. about 1766) with two brothers and one sister, Ann, emigrated from England about 1788. They landed at Perth Amboy, NJ and located for a while near New Brunswick, NJ. Ann married a man by the name of Davis and removed south. One of the brothers moved west, probably Ohio, and one remained in NJ. Thomas married in NJ where he resided until near the year 1801 at which time he removed to Ovid, Seneca Co. NY.” Also from Jerry Crary is the statement “Thomas married in 1791, **Ann Carrell/Coryell**. She died in 1843, he survived her 2 years and died in 1845. They are buried in a small cemetery near Buena Vista, Howard Township, Steuben Co. New York.”

There are two other Dunhams in Seneca County, New York in 1810 who are living in that part of Seneca County that became part of Tompkins County, New York in 1817. These other two Dunhams are: **Ezeriah Dunham** in Ovid, Seneca Co. NY in 1810 Census, p. 149; 10010-31010 and **John Dunham** in Hector, Seneca Co. NY in 1810 Census, p. 189; 00001-03001. Thus, we may have identified the “three brothers” mentioned by Jerry Crary, however it appears that Ezeriah Dunham was born in 1777 in New Jersey, so whether these three brothers and one sister actually came from England is still not clear. At any rate, the oldest brother appears to be John<sup>1</sup> Dunham who was over age 45 on the 1810 census and thus born before 1765. The second brother appears to be Thomas<sup>1</sup> Dunham whose birth year given by Jerry Crary is 1766. The third brother is Ezeriah/Azeriah<sup>1</sup> Dunham who was born 13 December 1777 in New Jersey.

The children of Thomas<sup>1</sup> and Ann (Coryell) Dunham are given in the book by Jerry Crary “*Ancestors and Descendants of Richard Dunham and his wife Laura Allen*” and Jerry Crary follows only the line of Richard<sup>2</sup> Dunham who married Laura Allen. Working with the information provided by Jerry Crary, I have been able to document the descendants of Thomas<sup>1</sup> Dunham through the census and land records.

### **The Line of Azeriah/Ezeriah Dunham**

Now because of finding Ezeriah Dunham's Civil War record I am able to connect this man to his father, also Ezeriah/Azeriah Dunham of Hector, Tompkins County, New York. That has allowed me to discover through census records the family makeup of Ezeriah Dunham (the father), and to learn the names of at least some of his children. This line would be Ezeriah <sup>1</sup> Dunham born in New Jersey 13 December 1777; died 10 March 1869 in Montour Falls, Schuyler County, New York. He probably had a first wife who was the mother of some of his children, and a second wife, Mary, who was the mother of the children born after 1820.

More work in the census records may allow me to follow some of these family lines further and possibly identify a male Dunham descendant who might participate in DNA analysis. If it is possible to do that it might then be possible to establish the complete Dunham ancestry of this line of Dunhams.
