Editor's Comments about This Issue

I have been researching Dunham families for over 40 years. In gathering material and compiling it into related family groups I have gained familiarity with the different Dunham/Donham/Dunnam families and their movements throughout North America. Now it is time to publish my hypothesis about the lines of Dunhams whose vital, historical or genealogical records have not been found by me, or whose records no longer exist.

In some cases we need to look at the most plausible connections by piecing together bits of evidence. In combining these bits of evidence with the known historical and geographical facts, and by understanding the culture of the time period we are researching, we can approach a conclusion. By using these conclusions with caution, but by publishing the results of our research, we can record our research so that a researcher in the future may perhaps build upon them. We are always hopeful that discovery of an old forgotten or misplaced document will clarify the evidence we have presented and solve the puzzle of lineage or origin.

With this issue I will begin by presenting my hypothesis on the line of Dennis Dunham/Donham of New Jersey and Kentucky. This line has been under investigation by descendants as well as by myself for many years. DNA results have shown it to originate with the Dunham-Singletary family of Woodbridge, New Jersey.

The Line of Dennis Dunham of Woodbridge, New Jersey

It has been eight years since my hypothesis as to the parents of Dennis Dunham/Donham b. in New Jersey about 1750/51 was printed in the DSFC Newsletter Vol. 6, Issue 1. I have done a lot of research since 2007 when I published several articles dealing with the line of Richard¹ Singletary, Jonathan² Dunham alias Singletary, David³ Dunham. Please review DSFC Newsletter Vol. 4, Issue 2, 15 April 2007 p. 35; and more specifically read the full article from Vol. 6, Issue 1, 15 January 2009 beginning on p. 7. The title of that article is "The Question of Dennis Dunham". In that article I point out the research of Gladys Donham who found documentation of two illegitimate children born to David³ Dunham prior to 1697. We know that there are unconnected Dunham/Donhams whose DNA analysis shows them to be descendants of the Singletary/Dunham line from Woodbridge, NJ. I believe that there is circumstantial evidence that shows that the line of Dennis Dunham connects to David³ Dunham through an illegitimate son.

There is a strong possibility that there was a John⁴ Dunham who was a son of David³ Dunham. We know that there was a John⁴ Donham who was son of Nathaniel³ Donham, and this John⁴ was born about 1708. However, the John⁴, son of Nathaniel³, was born in Westfield, Union County, New Jersey and I believe that there was another John⁴ Dunham who lived in Perth Amboy or Elizabethtown, New Jersey. This John⁴ Dunham may be one of the children born to David³ Dunham before 1697.

The list of Marriage Licenses from New Jersey Colonial Documents, p. 108 gives a marriage for John Donham and Sarah Dennis (Woodbridge marriage license dated 25 June 1744). The John Donham of the marriage license would have been born about 1720. Therefore, the father of this John would have been born about 1695-1697, based on the average age at which young men married at this period.

The parentage of both Dennis and Nathaniel Dunham has long been a mystery. Both were born in New Jersey. Descendants of both have had DNA analysis, and are shown by the results of that analysis to belong to the line of Jonathan² Dunham alias Singletary. The exact year of birth of these two Dunham/Donham men is unproven, but they would have been born in the 1720s or early 1730s. It is thought that Nathaniel Donham was born about 1733. We know that Dennis and Nathaniel were NOT brothers, but they may have been cousins.

John Donham of the 1744 marriage license would have been born say 1720, and I believe that he was a son of John⁴, illegitimate son of David³. This would make him John⁵ Donham, b. say 1720, m. 1744 Sarah Dennis. I believe they were the parents of Dennis⁶ Dunham/Donham born in 1750-51. It should be noted that the surname spelling changed from "DUNHAM" to "DONHAM" during this period.

It has been said that this Dennis Dunham was of Irish descent. It was NOT the Dunham or Donham ancestors who were Irish, but land records show that members of the DENNIS family were from Ireland.

Before presenting the descendants of Dennis ⁶ Donham I want to thank Gladys Donham, Randy Pace, and Victor Donham who have provided assistance to me over the years. Victor Donham participated in DNA analysis which proved his connection to the Singletary Dunham line. I also want to mention that much of the following information came from an old website produced by "Heather", and some material came from a web site called GenCircles which was absorbed by Heritage Quest in 2007. The material from "Heather" may still be found by using a search engine that can track old web sites. The reference given in my research data to her site is www.geocities.com/Heartland/Prairie/3443/cemetery.html/08-17-2004 Data in italics is from web sites, either Ancestry.com or GenCircles. It is unproven until I find references. Material from Census data is accurate. Anyone researching the following lines should search under both the Dunham and Donham surname spelling. I will use both spellings as found in the census data. Due to space limitations I have not included all the early census data in this article but I have referenced the years and locations where it may be found.

Numbering for this line will begin with Dennis ⁶ Donham as number 1, however he would be in the sixth generation. In this article I have carried the genealogy far enough in the eighth generation to document proof that the DNA analysis of Victor Reid Donham connects this family to the Dunham-Singletary line of Woodbridge, New Jersey. DNA test results may be found on the Dunham-Singletary.org web site.

GENERATION SIX

1. **Dennis ⁶ Donham** (John ^{5,4} David ³ Jonathan ² Dunham alias Singletary, Richard ¹ Singletary) b. 16 January 1751 in NJ; ^[1] d. about 1821 in Allen Co. KY. His will was dated 25 September 1821. He married **Dorothy Phillips**.

NOTE: Drakes Creek in Warren Co. KY is off of the Barren River to the south east of Bowling Green. It flows north west from Allen County. I believe the Donhams lived along Drakes Creek in the southern part of Warren Co. near the border with Allen Co. Dennis Dunham is found in the 1810 Census of Warren Co. KY. The line between Warren Co. and Allen Co. was established in 1820, and Allen had been a part of Warren Co. before that, so the Dunhams may not have actually moved, just lived in that part of Warren that became Allen Co. by 1820.

3. **Timothy ⁷ Dunham** (Dennis ⁶ John ^{5,4} David ³ Jonathan ² Dunham alias Singletary) b. about 1775; died about 1850. He married in Warren Co. KY 18 Oct. 1802 **Mary Harris**.

There is a Timothy Dunham listed as an Ensign in the Warren County Corn Stalk Militia 25th Regiment on 19 July 1806. Timothy was granted 200 acres in Warren Co. KY. Timothy ⁷ Dunham is found in the 1810 and 1820 census in Warren Co. KY. He was living in Lafayette Co. Missouri in 1830.

The marriage was consented to by Dennis Dunham, and witnessed by Timothy Dunham and Zachariah Morris. Bond was posted by Daniel Skaggs. Joseph Skaggs died before 1850 when Effie was living in Clay County, Missouri with her son Jonathan D. Skaggs.

In the Warren County, Kentucky Deed Books, page 169, Skaggs, Joseph and Effie, his wife, to Abraham Skaggs, consideration \$200, 100 acres of land next to John Spear and Joseph Hudspeth lines. This was dated 4 November 1811.

In the fall of 1846 he moved to Polk Co. Missouri, then in the fall of 1848 he moved to Johnson Co. Missouri. He was living with his son Winfield Scott Donham in Henry Co. Missouri in 1870.

Ira was sworn in for the Warren Co. KY Grand Jury in 1829, and also served as juror in the Warren Co. KY Circuit Court in 1833. In 1852, the Warren Co. KY Court ordered that the money be collected from the sale of the land of John Donham (his father), with Mary Donham (his mother) as widow, receiving 1/3 and the remaining heirs to receive 2/3. Ira is mentioned as an heir and received 1/11th.
