Item 4 – Membership Report - James Streeter

In 2025 DGRA had a total of 38 members vs 45 in 2024.

The bi-annual election of the Board of Directors took place in April 2026 with ballots being emailed out to the 37 members in good standing and we received back 20 with a Vote for All.

Item 6 - DNA Project Report - Jeff Dunham

James has started on reviewing the DNA project and will be adding new and updated into to the website as new info is reviewed. New section will be information of the Ancestral Migration Routes from the ancestral "Adam" beginning in Central Africa and also mtDNA female line information. Family Tree DNA has been sending lots of info on Dunham and Singletary lines since the 1st of the year, my DNA folder has over 550 messages on various levels that match into the two lines.

The Domain Registration is Current and paid to May 2026. Status on moving the DGRA Server from Jeff Dunham's home to a more reliable location is still in the work.

James has continues to needed updates and added new material to the DGRA web site. The main one is adding the indexing several years of News Letters and adding more descendants lines to the Dunham's in America section.

Item 10 – Facebook Page & Group: by Trudy Dunham

The Dunham Genealogy Research Association Facebook page has 230 followers (up from 228 in May 2024) but sees little traffic. The last posts were by Trudy in May 2024 with information on how to contact our Historian, but a follower indicated that the email wasn't working (historian@dunhamgenealogy.org). The Server was offline several times due to weather, JAS.

The DGRA FB group has 215 members (up from 190 members in May 2024) but sees little traffic and few posts. We had two interesting requests in January 2025 – one from a follower looking for the citations for research stated in an article in our newsletter and the acceptance of DNA in providing documentation of ancestry, and one from a Museum Director in New Smyrna Beach Florida searching for information on a founding family of their town.
